New Business

- 2010 Season Dual Meet Schedule

Explanation – Scheduling process attempts to give teams 2 or 3 home meets in alternating years. Exceptions would be teams moving into another division or a team new to league, which may disrupt this pattern. Also encourage teams to remain in their division for at

least 2 seasons to keep from alternating divisions every year. Finally an attempt to give prelim hosts an away meet prior to their event.

Also discussed the need for a change in the league's structure from 3 divisions to 4 due to the strength of our top A division teams.

It was moved and seconded to approve the meet schedule.

- Prelim Schedule

Jeff Ishee once again ran the numbers based on last year's entries. 8 & U prelim would end at 2:45 and the 13-18 prelim would end at 5:45 PM in a 6 lane pool. Based on this info, the board has scheduled the following:
